Moment of Silence - Quorum present, in-person and Zoom meeting called to order @ 1734

Motion to Approve Agenda, 2nd, Passed 6 to 0.

Tim Sawyer presented the FY 2021 Audit conducted by B&T on FSMA. Discussed overall findings and provided the full audit with an executive summary. It showed our financial "framework" performance for this last year meeting standard, except one section where we are approaching standard. Some Discussion about the amortization schedule, and FSMA requested our 990 and depreciation schedule form B&T. Overall, the school is in good financial position, revealing no issues as to fraud, waste or abuse, with accounting and financial systems functioning appropriately.

Secretary's Report: Motion to Approve Amended 28 September minutes, 2<sup>nd</sup>, Passed 6 to 0.

**Treasurer's Report:** J Berg. WSFS banking statements presented. Ongoing USDA withdrawals totaling some \$24k each month continue. Noted minimal interest earned. Discussed the Classy pay issues - will be paid from Board account. Payments for construction work are all current. Total in both accounts about \$387,041. Escrow accounts remain unfunded. Motion to Accept Treasurers report, 2<sup>nd</sup>, passed 8 to 0.

**Finance Report:** Commandant Gallucci. Provided updated Web Report and September numbers. Current budget - student count is 458. Transportation costs look to be \$467,000 for coming year - more than last year. Again noted that all meals are free for all students this year. Spending for September was about \$139,000, with student transportation, strong spend in instructional supplies, training, computer supplies. Reported \$0 remaining in Cares Act I (ESSER) and Cares Act II (ESSER II) budgets. ESSER III budgeted approx. \$722k.

Web Report was presented. Motion to accept, 2<sup>nd</sup> Passed 8 to 0.

**Commandants Report:** Report Attached. Commandant reported Open House date is 6 Nov 10 to 1PM. Discussion about the DOE required policy on vaccination status or testing. Will hold vote util next month's Board meeting. SMI provided a review of various events coming for Cadets - to include Cadet Change of Command, Marine Corps Ball, Raiders Competition in GA, Formation Run, and HITT Locker delivery by 30 October.
